RATIONALE

Highly Active Antiretroviral Therapy (HAART) had been a major breakthrough for the care of people with HIV. A great deal of advances had been reached in the field of antivirals, including Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP). Nevertheless, there are still some critical points, which need our attention and these involve chemsex, sexually transmitted infections (STI), implementation of PrEP services, needs of marginalized persons including migrants and inmates, elimination of stigma and discrimination, and the fundamental role of the third sector.
